ABSTRACT

Due to the increased complexity and wide adoption of information systems, security failures have become commonplace. Furthermore, a security failure may inevitably result to litigation actions as in many cases third parties may be adversely affected. As such, it is not a matter of "pulling the plug" or "rebooting the system"; the causes of failures as well as the offenders need to be identified and the corresponding digital evidence needs to be collected in a manner that it is admissible in a court of law. In this presentation we will initially introduce relevant terms such as cybercrime, digital evidence and incident response and present open research problems and challenges in this domain.
