### **ABSTRACT**

This research seminar considers the difficulties of cross-disciplinary research, and how they may be overcome, as well as the benefits that working across different disciplines can bring. Professor Hervey's work on the law of the European Union in the field of health is a perfect case study from which to consider these questions. Professor Hervey will reflect on how legal scholars design and conduct their research, the assumptions they make about the law, and their discipline. She will consider the extent to which these assumptions interact with or relate to assumptions about law and society that other social scientists may make, and how these interactions bring challenges (and delights) as one works across law and other disciplines.
