#### Scope of conference

In the context of the EU Lisbon strategy and the Greek Government's policy to promote research and development and particularly the promotion of the Thessaloniki Innovation Zone. this conference on Regional Innovation Strategy Entrepreneurship aims to contribute by demonstrating and disseminating European best practices, with a particular emphasis on British success in this field. Necessary infra-structural components and their relations will be considered, together with the necessary mechanisms for the successful commercialisation of innovation. Case studies will look particularly at some of the sectors of regional importance, such as agrobiotechnology, life sciences and nanotechnology in textiles. The workshops on the second day will examine what elements of that experience can be useful for regional innovation policy and practice in Greece and will further draw conclusions on the steps that must be taken to move ahead.

Moreover, the conference aims at the creation of an ongoing dynamic regional forum in SE Europe that will discuss and promote policies and programmes in the area of Innovation & Entrepreneurship. The established regional network will also contribute to the discussions of future Regional Innovation Planning for the Period 2007-2013 both for Greece and the neighbouring preaccession countries.
